Route extended to Waterfront City and NewQuay, Docklands

The City Circle Tram provides a free and convenient way for visitors to see the sights of Melbourne.

Now, the route has been extended to take in the popular NewQuay and Waterfront City precincts of the Melbourne Docklands (see map overleaf).

Trams run in both directions approximately every 12 minutes between 10am and 6pm from Sunday to Wednesday and between 10am and 9pm every Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

City Circle Trams do not run on Christmas Day or Good Friday.
