TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS - TRAMS AND BUSES.

TRAMS:

SWANSTON ST. Southbound trams to shunt at Public Library Crossover from 10.0 a.m. and Northbound trams to shunt at the Princes Bridge crossover from the same time.

COLLINS ST.
