- 6** Moreland - Glen Iris  
**Route 6** will be extended from Melbourne University to Moreland, replacing **Route 8**.
- 58** West Coburg - Toorak via William St  
**Route 58** will be introduced to replace **Route 8** and **Route 55**, running from Toorak to West Coburg.

- New timetables on all routes
- More capacity where it's needed
- More reliable journey times
- Low floor trams to the Parkville hospital precinct
- **Route 8** replaced by routes **58** and **6**

**Do you currently catch Route 8?**

Please change at Domain Interchange to travel to St Kilda Rd and Swanston St. A connecting tram is about 1 minute away between 7am and 7pm on weekdays and 10am and 7pm on weekends.

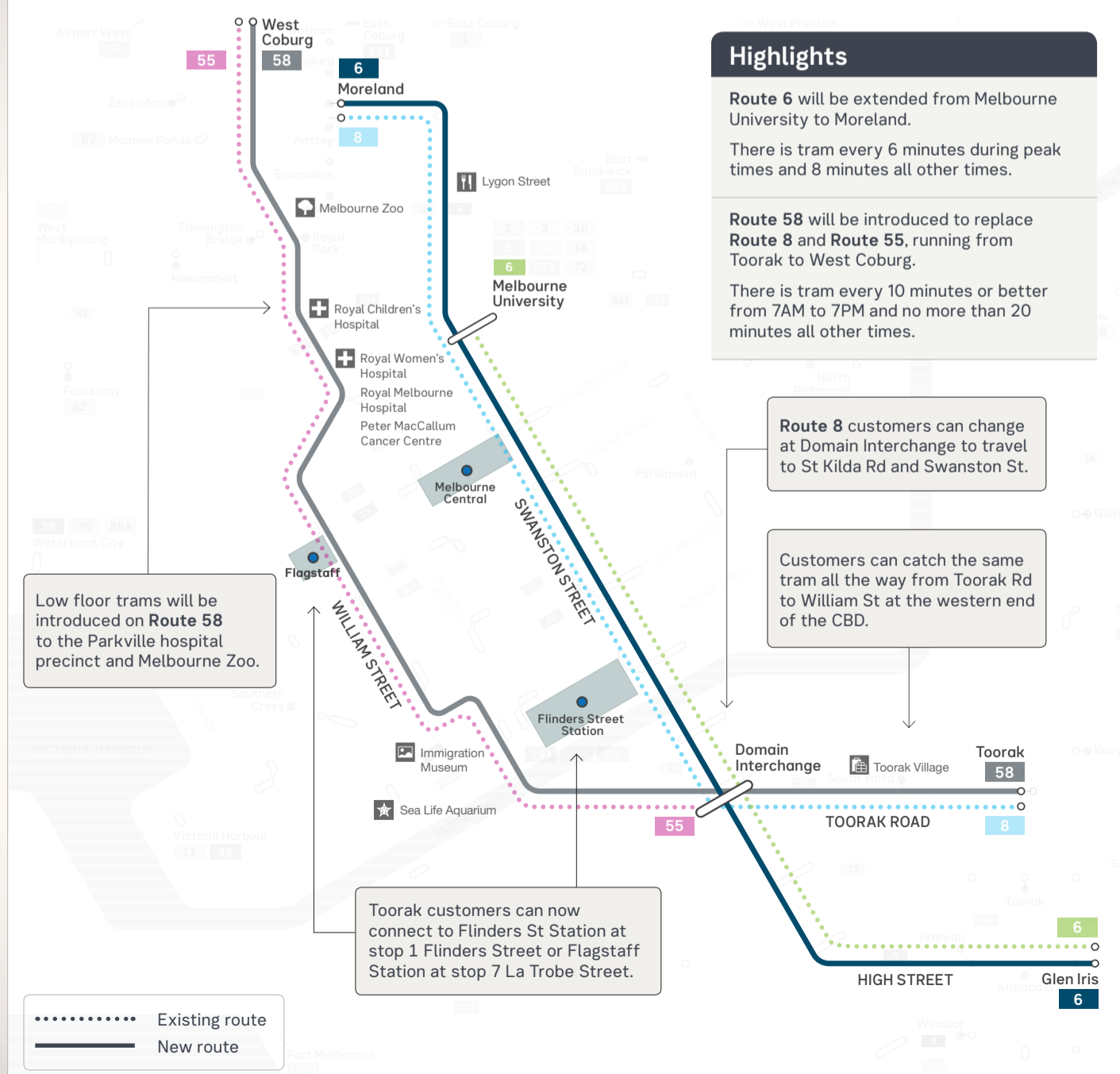
## Where can you go on Route 6?

**Connecting:** Prahran Station, Armadale Station.

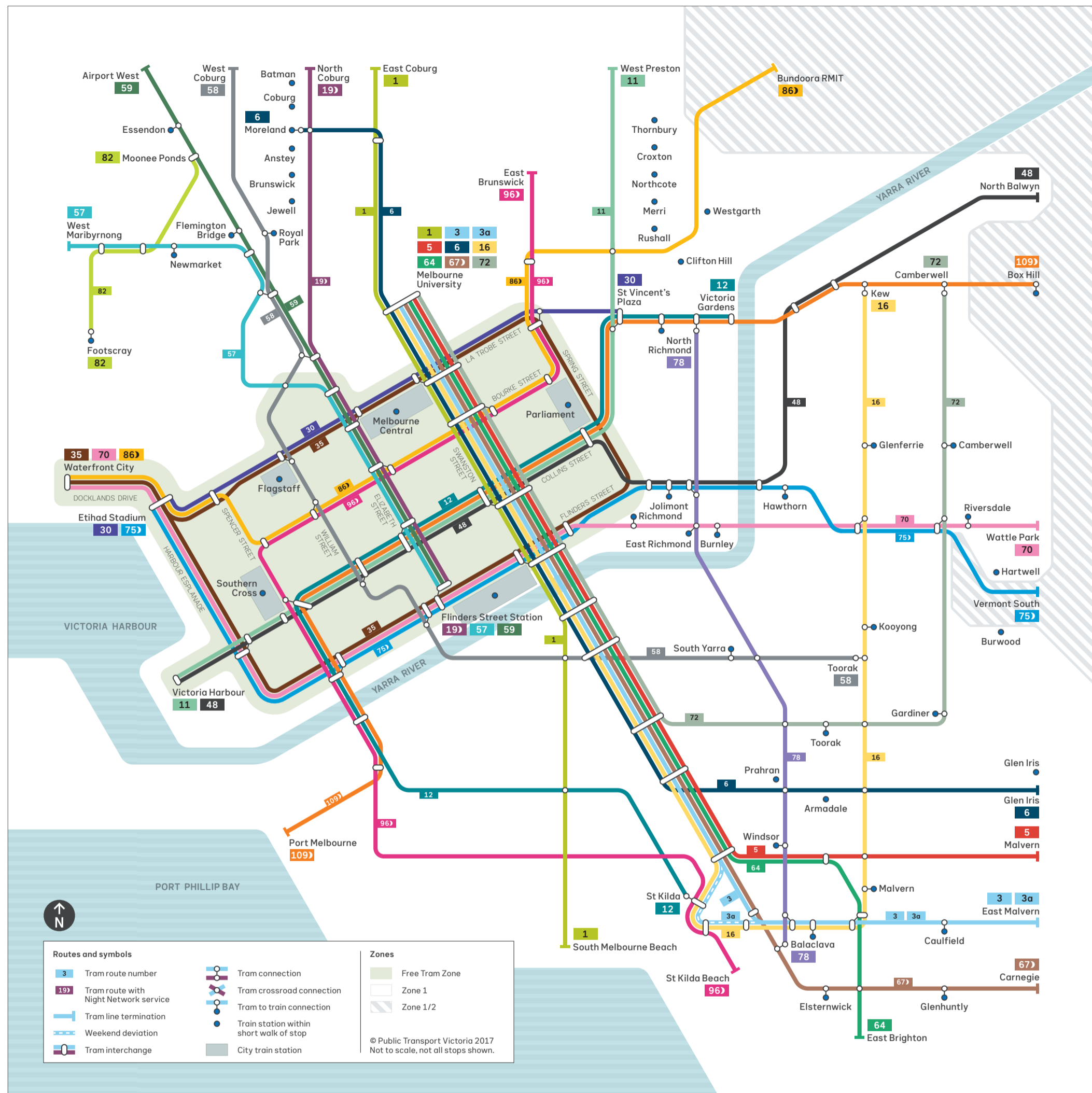
**Local area:** Brunswick East, Coburg.
