It has come to our attention that some periodical tickets are being incorrectly stamped. Therefore all tickets sellers, please be reminded of the correct procedure for stamping expiry dates on Weekly and Monthly Tickets.

### WEEKLY TICKETS

Weekly Tickets are available for seven (7) consecutive days travel only,

e.g. a weekly ticket issued on Wednesday 22 June 1994 is stamped to expire the following Tuesday 28 June 1994.

The **only** exception is for tickets issued after 3.00pm, which shall commence availability from the next day, but may be used from the time of issue.

### MONTHLY TICKETS

Monthly Tickets are available for one (1) consecutive months travel only. Therefore the number of days the ticket is available will vary according to the date and month the ticket is issued.


e.g.	Date Issued	Expiry Date
	21.09.94	20.10.94
	30.09.94	29.10.94
	29.01.95	28.02.95
	30.01.95	28.02.95

All ticket issuing points should have a Met Fares and Ticketing Manual and this should be referred to for regulations covering the issuing of tickets (See section 1.9 page 25).

Any person demanding extended expiry dates be stamped on their tickets should be refused and informed that this is fraudulent use and may result in a hefty fine.
