APPEARANCE BEFORE TRAFFIC PERSONNEL OFFICE

I refer to your letter of 27 February, 1991, requesting the Corporation change the present procedure which provides for "suspension from duty without pay" to "relieved from duty with pay until brought before a panel" in relation to traffic collisions and other discipline matters.

Following discussions with Industrial Relations and the Traffic Personnel Office, the Corporation has agreed to your request, and accordingly the new procedure is to read as follows. "Relieved from duty with pay until brought before a panel for a decision and should the employee concerned be found negligent, then the payment for the time of the suspension will be reviewed, having regard to the circumstances involved".

This procedure will be implemented from Sunday 28 April, 1991 and is to be reviewed periodically.


However, should members of your Association refuse to attend or place bans on the Traffic Personnel Office this agreement may be revoked immediately.
