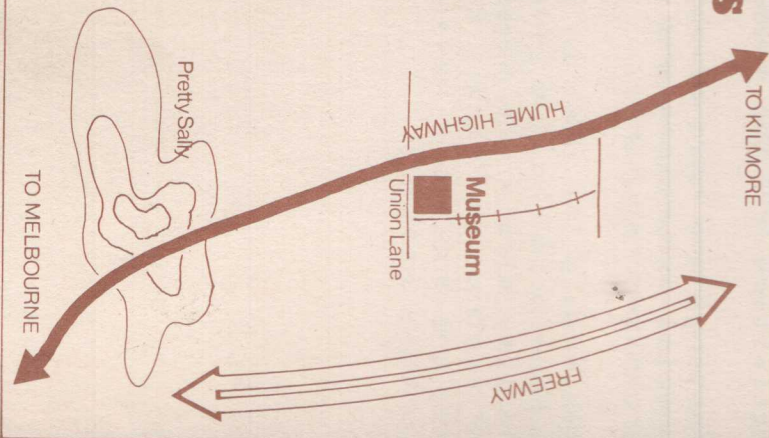

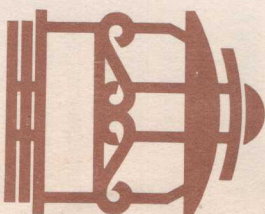

is dedicated to establishing a representative collection of tramcars, equipment, relics and records illustrating the development and diversity of Victoria's tramways.

Victoria's Tramway Museum at Bylands

An operating museum to house and display the collection is being constructed by Society members along a former railway right-of-way at Bylands, near Kilmore [50 km from the city along the Hume Highway].

Open Sundays 11 am to 5 pm

An 1888 vintage horse tram operates regularly for the enjoyment of visitors.

Many different cable and electric trams have been acquired and are on public display. Eventually the electric trams will be operated under power to carry visitors along the 1.5 km line.

The museum construction work and tramcar restoration is carried out by voluntary labours of Society members. New members are always welcome.

The project is financed from within the Society by subscriptions donations, sales and fund raising activities. Considerable financial support is needed and all contributions are welcomed.

Donations of \$2.00 and over are **INCOME TAX DEDUCTABLE.**

Development plans include the acquisition and restoration of further trams, the provision of additional display buildings and public facilities and the electrification of the museum tramway.

Society Membership

All members and friends are welcome to participate in Society activities and the museum project.

Meetings are held bi-monthly and special excursions and tours are organised regularly.

Membership includes an annual subscription to the bi-monthly 'Trolley Wire' - the magazine of Australian Tramway Museums - and the Society's newsletter 'Running Journal'.
