Since the S.E.C. tramway system closed in Geelong in 1956, Putterbox 9 has been housed in a farm shed. It is in fairly good condition (especially the roof) and is intact apart from controllers, truck and trolley pole (all of which we have ready to install once it gets here).

The car has cost us \$400 to purchase and the transport quote is \$600. Thus we need a cool \$1,000 right now! We have to shift the car within four weeks so you can see the urgency of our appeal.

We don't need to point out that it is <u>very</u> hard to get <u>any</u> refund back from the Taxation Department these days but your donation will automatically yield a refund cheque next year.
