BREWERY TRUCK RIPS TRAM: 2 DIE

TWO passengers died when a tram and a brewery truck crashed at Clifton Hill last night.

The truck ripped the side out of the tram, spilling beer kegs into the tram and across the street.

Twenty-two people were injured, two seriously.

The semi-trailer is owned by Carlton and United Breweries.

Many of the injured were taken to hospital. Two are serious.

One of them, Mr Gregory Heyfield, 20, of Gower St., Preston, was operated on at St. Vincent's Hospital last night.
