THIS is one of 10 new orange tramway buses which have begun service in the metropolitan area.

Twenty more are being assembled in Sydney and all should be in operation this year.

They were built in England by Leyland and cost \$32,000 each.

Bus driver Bruce McKae, of Thornbury, said the new buses were easier to handle than the old ones.

"They are very manoeuvrable in heavy traffic and have a very acute turning circle," he said.

"The ride is smoother and the driver's seat and passengers' seats are more comfortable."
