

An 18-ton truck loaded with asphalt and two trams collided in the city this afternoon.

No one was injured. The accident happened at the corner of Spring St. and Collins St., at 2.15 p.m.

The truck driver, Greg Gerard, said his brakes failed when he went to stop at the Spring St. lights.

The truck bit a stationary car and careered across the intersection.
