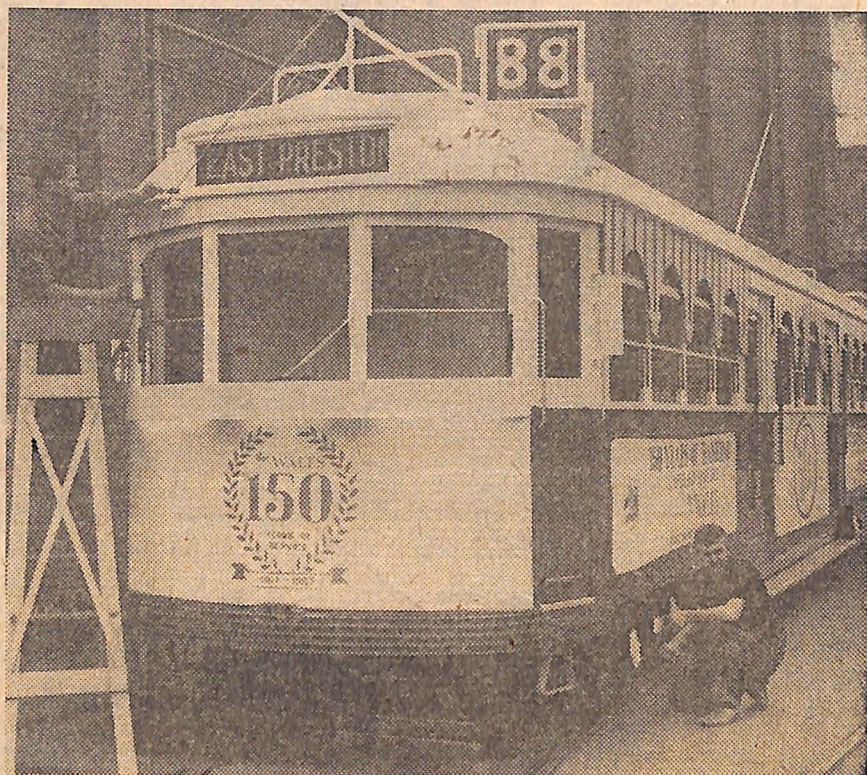


Special tram gets a lift
