

A Melbourne tram sets out on a long journey — as an export to the United States. Two of the ancient green and gold trams are going to the City of Seattle as tourist attractions. They will run along a 2.1 km line along the waterfront beside Puget Souna. The Tramways Board sold the trams for \$5000 each. Transport to the States will add \$20,000 each to their cost. The first tram to leave was put on a low-loader yesterday at the Preston Tramways Workshops, and taken through the city to the docks where it will be lifted aboard the Al lunga for its trip across the Pacific.
