Right turn changes

On January 30, we:

- permanently removed right turns from Olympic Boulevard to Punt Road, and
- temporarily banned right turns from Punt Road to Swan Street

These changes are part of the final continuous flow design and will help improve travel times, reduce queues and give you more go time on Punt Road.

Olympic Boulevard closure

We'll also close Olympic Boulevard between Punt Road and AAMI Park from 11pm, 7 February to 6am. 12 February. These closures apply to both trams and vehicles. During the closure, we'll upgrade the tram tracks so we can build a new, accessible tram stop on Swan Street later this year. We'll also prepare the road for two new turning lanes from Punt Road to Olympic Boulevard.

Punt Road walking changes

From 30 January, we'll also close the pedestrian crossing on Punt Road near the rail bridge and across Olympic Boulevard. To get from Olympic Boulevard to Swan Street, you can use the new raised footpath under the bridge, cross at Brunton Avenue, then back to Swan Street on the existing footpath or via Stewart Street.

Plan your journey

We'll have detours in place for all changes. Visit our website for detailed information and maps.

Detours may add up to an hour to your journey so please plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

Major works at Brunton Avenue are now complete.
