SIGN RE BAND RECITALS AT WATTLE PARK.

TO BE DISPLAYED AT BATMAN AVENUE.

Arrangements have been made for a series of Sunday Band Recitals to be given at Wattle Park by the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Band as per the accompanying schedule.

In past years it has been the practice to display a sign approximately 3 feet deep by 6 feet wide underneath our special route indicator board across the footpath at the corner of Batman Avenue and Princes Bridge.
