Cars on Flinders Street routes will be shunted on the East and West sides of Swanston Street from 12.55 to 1.40 p.m. approx., and again at Market Street "up" cars will shunt from 1.35 to 2.5 p.m. approx., while "down" cars will be held West of Market Street from 1.35 p.m. until all is clear at this point.

Arrange for Inspector to keep in close touch and adjust cars to schedule time after procession has finished.
