4. TROOPS TAKING PART:





West Mclbourne buses to be diverted from Flinders Street and Elizabeth Street to Lonsdale Street and to turn east of Flizabeth Street at 1 p.m. Collingwood buses to turn on east side of Swanston Street in Flinders Street from 12.55 p.m.

Coode Canal buses to be diverted to Spencer Street at 1.30 p.m.

TRAFFIC GENERALLY

Traffic to be kept cut of Alexandra Avenue from Linlithgov Avenue to St. Kilda Road from 11.30 a.m. and out of Linlithgov Avenue from 12.15 p.m.

No kerbside parking to be permitted on the route of the Parade from 12.30 p.m. until after the Parade is concluded.

Alexandra Avenue between St. Kilda Road and Linlithgow Avenue to be kept clear of cars.

Barriers to be closed at 1 p.m. or earlier should the Police so direct.

Vehicular traffic in the vicinity of the route of the Parade to be stopped and diverted by the Police at 12.45 p.m. or earlier should the Police so direct.

AMBULANCE STATIONS
