Dear Madam,

Replying to your letters of the 24th and 26th ultimo, I have to inform you that the Board will be pleased to allow your Auxiliary and the 2/2nd Pioneer Men's Association to hold a picnic and sports meeting at Wattle Park on A.N.A. Day, 28th January next, subject to the observance of the By-laws (copy enclosed).

As there will be a considerable number of people visiting the Park on that day, the Oval cannot be used for your sports, but a suitable area adjacent to the picnic sites at the north-eastern end of the Park can be made available, and I would suggest that you call on the Curator at his office in the Park (phone WX.1104) who will be pleased to indicate to you the site suggested, also the positions where the marquees and merry-go-round may be erected.

Your Committee will be held responsible for any damage to trees, fences, etc. by those who attend the picnic, and for the gathering of paper and other debris resulting from the holding of same. As the lighting of fires within the Park is prohibited, you will require to obtain any hot water you may need from the Lessee of the Park Chalet.

The tram service from Princes Bridge to Wattle Park on A.N.A. Day will be at 10-minute intervals from 10 a.m. but it may be possible to augment the service on that day.
