Definition.

The word "adult" includes any person above the age of 12 years.

Provided that one child under the age of three years, if accompanied by a person who has paid an adult fare, shall be permitted to travel free, but only if in arms or seated on the knee of such adult passenger.

SCHOLARS' CONCESSION FARES.

The fares for children under the age of 17 years when travelling to and from school shall be the following concession fares by tickets:—

Tickets are only available for a journey commenced before 6.30 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive, and before 1 p.m. on Saturday.

Tickets are not available on Sundays nor during the school vacations; but may be used by scholars attending school on any other day.

ROUND TRIP EXCURSION TICKETS.

The fare for each continuous journey in the one direction through Melbourne, St. Kilda, Caulfield, Malvern, Hawthorn, Kew, and Richmond, or vice versa, to starting point, available from any point in the round trip—on day of issue only—by the following Cable and Electric Tramways, as follows:—

Electric Cars between Melbourne Town Hall and Carlisle St., St. Kilda;

Electric Cars between Carlisle St., St. Kilda, and Victoria Street Bridge;

Cable Cars between Victoria Street Bridge and Melbourne Town Hall;
shall be:—

Adults and Children over 12 years of age One Shilling

Children (under 12 years of age) Sixpence

CHARGES FOR EXCESS LUGGAGE.

The charge to be paid by each passenger upon any tramway of the Board who shall take with him permitted personal luggage, parcels, or packages exceeding in the aggregate 28 lbs., but not exceeding 56 lb. in weight, or 36 x 18 x 12 inches in dimension, shall be an additional full fare. Luggage, parcels, or packages, exceeding 56 lbs. in weight, or 36 x 18 x 12 inches in dimension, are not permitted.

CHARGES FOR CARRIAGE OF NEWSPAPERS.

The charge to be made for parcels of Newspapers addressed to Newsagents and carried upon any tramway of the Board shall be one adult fare for each parcel separately addressed not exceeding 28 lbs. in weight, and two adult fares for each parcel exceeding 28 lbs., but not exceeding 56 lbs. in weight. Parcels exceeding 56 lbs. in weight, or 36 x 18 x 12 inches in dimension, are not to be carried.

When parcels of Newspapers are accompanied by a passenger they are to be treated as Personal Luggage.

SPECIAL CARS AND BUSES.

Charges and conditions of hire may be obtained on application at Head Office.

MINIMUM CHARGE UPON CERTAIN CARS.

Whenever indicated by notice on the car the minimum adult fare shall be as thereon specified.

HALFPENNY FARES FOR DENTAL CENTRE SCHOLARS.

Fare Concession Certificates are issued to Head Masters of all Suburban State Schools for use by teachers when travelling with scholars between their respective schools and the Dental Centre in the Domain, St. Kilda Road.

Available only on Week Days (Saturdays and Holidays excepted) between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.

Certificate to be produced by the teacher when paying the fares.

Fare for each scholar is ONE HALFPENNY for a single journey on any car.

This fare does not entitle the scholar to a transfer.

Teachers will pay ordinary full fare for themselves.

Tickets of large denomination to the value of total fares paid, to be issued to the teacher.

Note to be made on Journal of number of scholars carried on these concession fares. No. of Certificate to be quoted in each case.

SWIMMING CLASS TICKETS.

During the Summer Season (1st November to 30th April, inclusive), these tickets are to be accepted from State School Children under 16 years of age, attending Swimming Classes in squads of not less than 5. Each ticket will represent a fare for one child for a single journey on any line between the School and the Baths.

Tickets are only available on week days, Monday to Friday inclusive, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Not good for use on any Public Holidays, or between 19th December and 2nd January, inclusive.

Not available for Transfer.

POST OFFICE EMPLOYEES' TICKETS.

These tickets are to be accepted from Letter Carriers and Telegraph Messengers (if permanent men, when wearing their full uniform, or, if casual men, when wearing a Red Arm Badge lettered "P.M.G." and a number below in black) as payment of a fare, for two sections on any day (Sundays and Holidays included). 2d. cash fare ticket properly marked for the sections over which the holder is entitled to travel must be issued for each ticket received.

The paragraph on Page 21, dealing with Charges for Excess Luggage is also applicable to parcels, bags, or other mail matter carried by such P.O. Employees.
