SCHOLARS' CONCESSION TICKETS

CONDITIONS OF ISSUE FOR TERM AND YEARLY TICKETS

1. Tickets are issued only for the use of Scholars under 19 years of age, and may be used only for journeys to and from school by the Scholars to whom they are issued, provided such journeys are travelled between the points set out on the ticket. Tickets are not transferable.
2. Tickets are issued only upon requisition furnished on the current completed application form, which should be lodged at the beginning of each year, signed by the Principal of the School which the Scholar attends, and by a Parent or Guardian certifying the correctness of the details shown therein.
3. Scholars must travel to the nearest stop to the School (as determined by the Board) but may join the Board's services at the point most convenient to them.
4. Tickets are available—
 For travel only in accordance with the following times:
 Mondays to Fridays (Public Holidays if applicable) (For ordinary school work):
 To School—For journeys on Board's vehicles boarded before 6.30 p.m.
 From School—For journeys on Board's vehicles boarded before 8.00 p.m.
 Saturdays (For ordinary school work):
 To and from School—For journeys on Board's vehicles boarded before 1.15 p.m.
5. Tickets are not available for use:
 (a) On "Chartered" or "Special" trams and buses.
 (b) On Saturdays for Sporting Events, Cadets, Detention, Choir Practice, Special Tuition or any activity other than normal class work.
 (c) On Sundays or during school vacations.
6. Unless the ticket is shown to the Conductor of the vehicle on each journey or upon demand, a cash fare must be paid. Presentation of a Scholar's Concession Ticket at a later date will not be accepted as payment.
7. Any mutilation of a ticket, alteration or erasure thereon will render the ticket invalid and it must be replaced.
 Lost and Mutilated Tickets will be replaced only at Head Office on payment of a prescribed fee. A Statutory Declaration Form (obtainable at Head Office or any Depot) must be completed before a replacement ticket is issued.
8. Scholars travelling on concession tickets shall not occupy a seat on any vehicle if an adult passenger is unable to obtain seating accommodation on such vehicle, nor shall they be entitled to ride in a smokers compartment of any tram unless accompanied by an adult.
9. Scholars must ensure that school bags and cases are not placed in a position in vehicles where they will cause inconvenience to other passengers.
10. Any wilful breach of these conditions or any misconduct on the Board's vehicles may necessitate the confiscation of the ticket by an Officer of the Board and could render the pupil ineligible to obtain any further tickets.

 Head Office (8.15 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.) Depots (8.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.)

Yearly Tickets may be purchased from Head Office (times as shown)

OR

Term and Yearly Tickets may be obtained by mailing payment (including postage 7 cents) together with completed application form to Head Office.

Payment for two terms only will not be accepted.
