MEDICAL STANDARD - EYESIGHT.

Further to my memo. of 4th September, please note that the Board has adopted the following Medical Standard - Eyesight.

This supersedes all previous directions in this matter.

Conductors or Conductresses:

- (a) Uncorrected vision in each eye 6/18.
- (b) Corrected vision with glasses 6/9, 6/12.
- (c) If an applicant for the position of Conductor (not including Conductresses) can pass a corrected vision test with glasses he may be accepted for employment.

Drivers - Tram or Bus:

6/9 in one eye and 6/12 in the other without glasses.

If at any time during an employee's service as a tram or bus driver his eyesight deteriorates and can be corrected to 6/9 and 6/12 with glasses, he be permitted to continue in his occupation.

For Promotion to the Grade of Traffic Officer, Staff Signaller or Signaller:

Corrected vision with glasses 6/9, 6/12.

For Non-Traffic Employees required to driver Trams:

Corrected vision with glasses 6/9, 6/12.
