

Route 12 and **109** trams divert via La Trobe Street, between Stop 124 Batman Park and Stop 12 St Vincent's Plaza.

 - Buses replace **Route 58** trams between Stop 119 Wells St and West Coburg, diverting around the work zone via Queen Street.


Route 86 trams run in sections, with no trams between Stop 1 Southern Cross Station and Stop 4 Queen St.

Route 96 trams divert via La Trobe Street, between Stop 122 Southern Cross Station and Stop 11 Melbourne Museum.

Changes following William Street works

Once the works are complete, you'll see improvements to stops along William Street. Some stops that are close together will be removed and replaced with new accessible stops.

Parallel platform stops are built by raising the tram stop to give level access to the tram. These stops separate passengers, vehicles and bikes, improving safety.


