As Lord Huntingfield set foot on the pier the first of a salute of 17 guns, fired by the 15th Brigade (Australian Field Artillery) boomed out from the shore, and a flight of military aeroplanes, flying in V formation, dipped in salute. At the same moment the guard of honour furnished by the Royal Australian Navy presented arms and the band struck up the National Anthem. The crowds on the Esplanade began to cheer enthusiastically, the guns of the shore battery continued to boom, the school children at the shore end of the pier wildly fluttered their little flags, and the aeroplanes, banking steeply,

added a background of deep sound to the chorus of cheers. Next moment Lord Huntingfield stepped forward briskly and began to inspect the guard of honour, whose commanding officer he congratu-

lated upon the smart appearance of the ranks.
