BANDS AT COMO PARK

MASSED RECITAL TO-DAY

Finish of Centenary Thousand

As an entertainment for spectators waiting to see the finish of the Centenary Thousand cycling race at Como Park this afternoon, a recital by massed bands has been arranged by the Centenary Council. It will begin at 2.30 p.m. At 5 p.m. the Band of the Grenadier Guards will take part. The race is expected to finish about 3.30 p.m. If the weather is fine Mrs. Sidney Myer will present to the winner of the race the gold cup, which was donated by her husband.

Como Park, which will accommodate 80,000 people, is at the corner of the Alexandra avenue extension and Williams road.

Como Park Pageant Abandoned

Owing to the danger of rain the proposal to hold an international pageant at Como Park on October 27 to entertain the crowd waiting for the finish of the Centenary Thousand cycling race has been abandoned. The Centenary organiser (Brigadier-General C. H. Jess) explained yesterday that as there was no shelter at Como Park the delicate fabrics of the costumes might be damaged by a heavy downpour. The costumes would be needed for the International Club's pageant at the Town Hall on November 20 and 21. An alternative entertainment would be arranged. The services of the Grenadier Guards' Band had been promised.
