We are informed that some Conductors are telling Returned Soldiers of every class that on application at the Barracks, St.Kilda Road, they can obtain concession Tramway Tickets.

Conductors are hereby informed that the concessions given do not apply to all Returned Soldiers, but only to "1914" men and to those still under hospital treatment.

No Conductor should have given any directions without instructions to do so by notice, and such instructions have not been issued.

Should inquiries be made of Conductors in future, they are to refer inquirers to the office at the Barracks, where full particulars can be got.

RETURNED SICK OR WOUNDED SOLDIERS' CONCESSION TICKETS.

These tickets entitle Returned Soldiers to travel over any route or section for which the ordinary cash fare is TWOPENCE.

Soldiers using these tickets upon the Esplanade, Brighton Road, Prahran or Toorak Lines require to give a second ticket SHOULD THEY TRAVEL BEYOND THE END OF THE TWOPENNY SECTION.

NOTICE TO CONDUCTORS.

BLINDED SOLDIERS.

Cardboard Passes, with blue back, have been issued to Blinded Soldiers entitling them to travel with an attendant, FREE over the Tramways.

The red back cardboard pass will be issued to ordinary blind people as heretofore but in these cases a single fare must be paid to cover both the blind person and his or her attendant.

When the above passes are availed of, the name of the blind person must be entered on the Special Day Report as usual.
