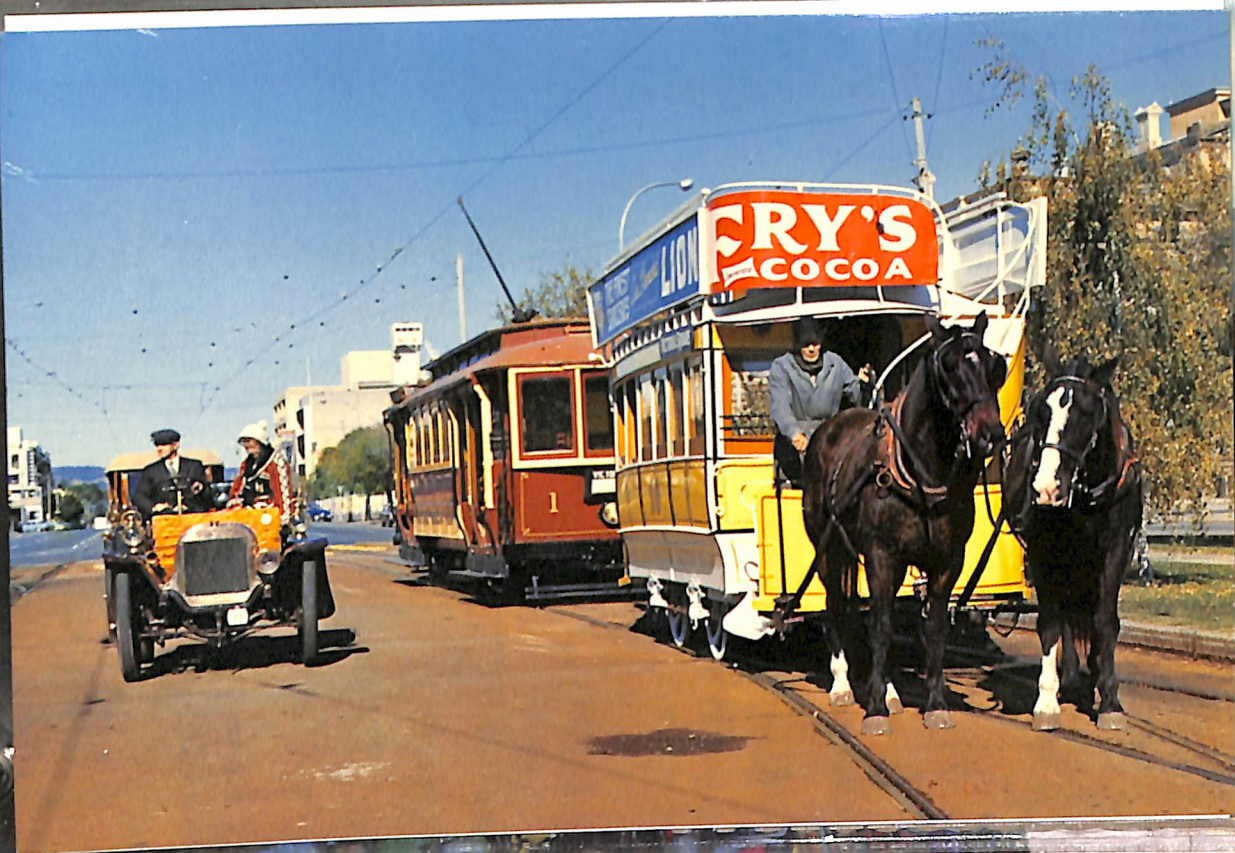
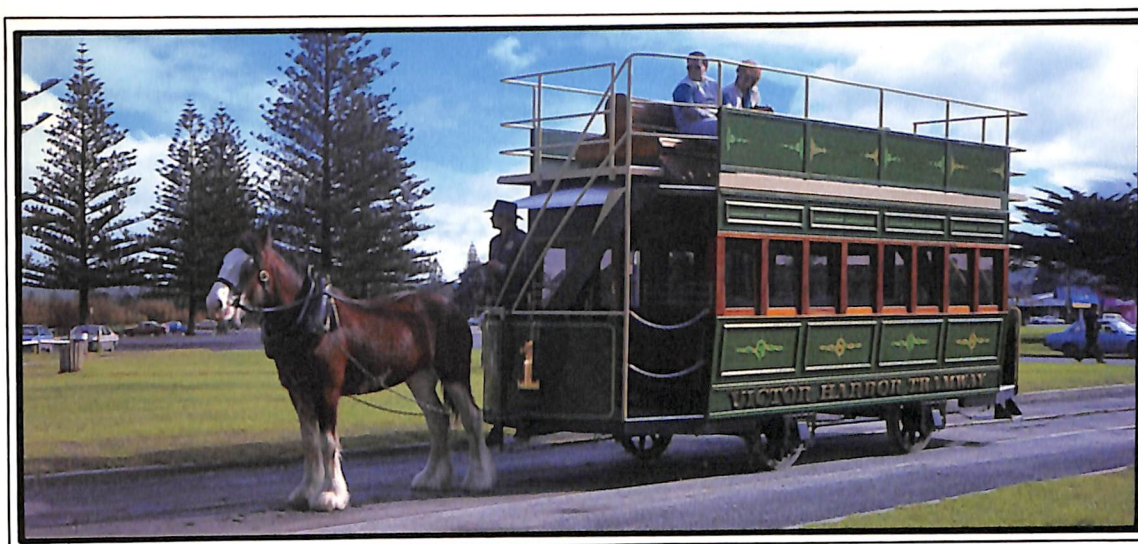

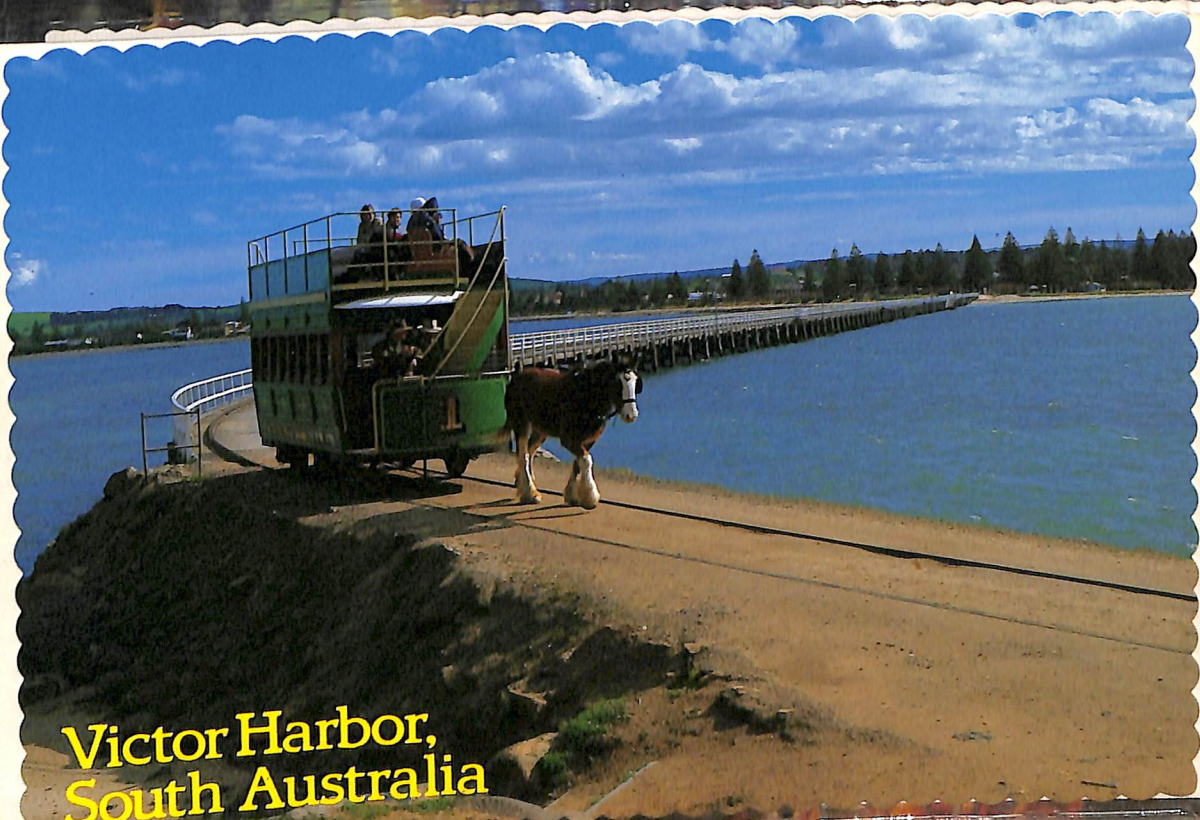


### Granite Island HORSE - DRAWN TRAMS

The Causeway connecting Granite Island to Victor Harbor was completed in 1875, enabling horses to haul trucks to the Island loaded with wool and grain for export by sailing ships. Steam locos replaced horses for a few years, but in 1895 passenger trams commenced. Using trams as pictured, the service operated for 59 years until abandoned in 1954 due to high costs of relaying the track. In Jubilee Year 1986 the re-created trams and new track brought the past to life again. It is the only horse-drawn tramway in Australia.

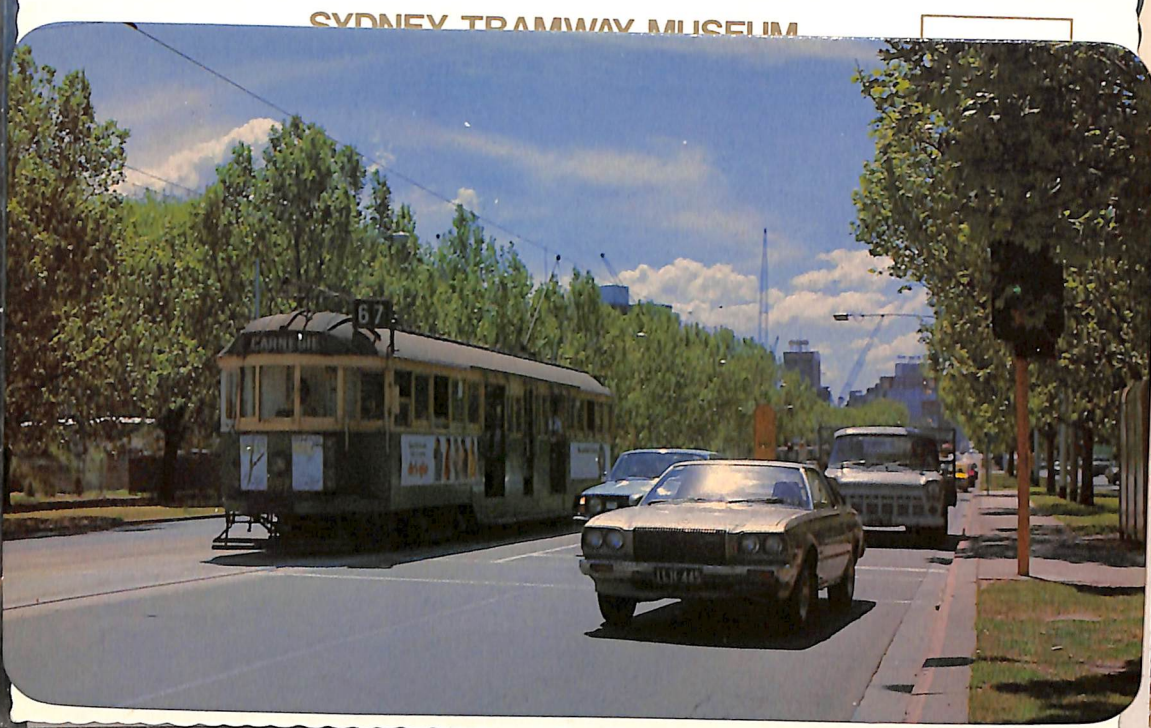

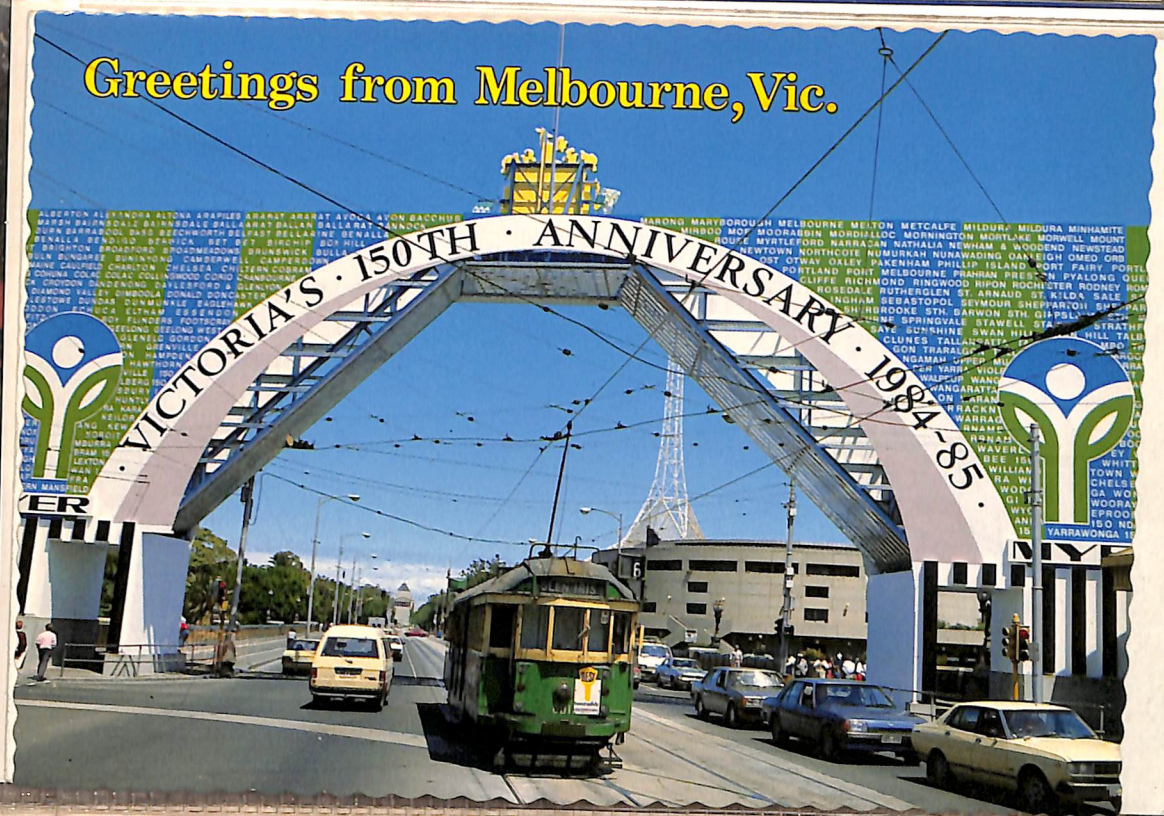
VICTOR HARBOR
