About The Met...

This brochure will help you make the best use of Melbourne's public transport - The Met. It's easy to travel around Melbourne on The Met - you can change from tram to train to bus all on one ticket. Three fare zones apply and the ticket you buy will depend on the amount of time you need. Tickets can be purchased at train stations, on board trams and buses, at the City Met Shop and various retail outlets.

Train, tram and Met buses generally operate between 5 am and midnight Monday to Saturday and 8 am to 11 pm Sundays. Operating hours vary for local bus services run by private companies. Contact the Met Information Centre on 131 638 for further details.

Met tickets are color coded - Zone 1 are yellow, Zone 2 are blue, Zone 3 are red. Zones 1 + 2 are yellow, 1 + 2 + 3 are yellow, blue and red.

There are two types of Met tickets - paper and scratch. Scratch tickets can be purchased as you need them or in bulk from the City Met Shop and various retail outlets. The full range of Met paper tickets can be purchased from train stations, but cannot be bought in bulk. The Met's 2 Hour, Daily and 60 Plus tickets can be purchased on board trams and buses, from retail outlets, train stations and the City Met Shop.

*Retail outlets: Selected newspapers, chemists, milk bars and mixed businesses.

Unlimited travel for at least two hours - perfect for shopping, lunches and appointments. 2 Hour tickets can be purchased from train stations, on board trams and buses. You can also buy 2 Hour tickets at the City Met Shop and retail outlets - where if you buy the handy five pack you will receive around a 10% discount.

One of the most popular Met tickets - it puts Melbourne on your doorstep and is ideal for a day out. Daily tickets can be purchased from train stations, on board trams and buses, the City Met Shop and retail outlets.

Whatever your needs - we've got the ticket

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Weekly tickets

Great value for the commuter. If you are a regular Met user then the Weekly is a smart buy - seven days travel for about the price of four. Weekly tickets can be purchased from train stations, the City Met Shop and retail outlets.

Monthly and Yearly tickets

For regular commuters a Monthly or Yearly ticket is easy, convenient and even better value. Monthly and Yearly tickets can be purchased from train stations, tram and Government bus depots and the City Met shop. Retail outlets also sell Monthly tickets.

60 Plus tickets

A special daily ticket for use anywhere on the Met System, for holders of the Seniors Card or 60 Plus Concession Card available to people 60 years and over who work less than 35 hours per week and are residents of Victoria. 60 Plus tickets can be purchased from train stations, on board trams and buses, the City Met Shop and retail outlets.

Zone 1 short trips

Short Trip Cards: 10 - 'two section' trips on trams and buses within Zone 1. They can be purchased from train stations, the City Met Shop and retail outlets in Zone 1 (not on board vehicles). Rail Plus Two tickets: for short train trips of up to two stations within Zone 1. They can be purchased from train stations in Zone 1.

Off-Peak Saver tickets

Discount train travel to the city is available from Zone 2 or Zone 3 on weekdays between 9.30am and 4pm and after 6pm. It also entitles you to travel on trams and buses in the City Saver area during these times. Details at your local station.

Family tickets

A great value daily ticket for up to two adults and six children. For use on trains, trams and buses anywhere in the Melbourne metropolitan area. Available from train stations.

Group Get•A•Bout

The Group Get•A•Bout ticket is great for groups and families of up to six people. The combination can vary but there is a limit of two adults.

Group Travel

Groups of 12 people or more, travelling at concession fares. Ask how at station.

Concession tickets are available for under 15 years and to holders only of the approved concession cards:

- PTC Primary/Secondary Card
- PTC Statewide Tertiary Card
- Dept of Social Security Cards
- Health Care Card
- Health Benefits Card
- Pensioner Transport Concession Card
- Seniors Card
- 60 Plus Concession Card

The holder must carry the concession card whilst travelling on PTC services.

A number of services are available to passengers with special needs.
