Burnley, Park Grove 1018, Glenferrie & Riversdale Roads 1025, Glenferrie & Dandenong Roads 1042, Glenferrie & Malvern Roads 1049, Gardiner 1058, Domain Road 1122, St. Kilda Junction 1134, via route 64 & 69 to Glenferrie & Riversdale Roads 1158, car in Hawthorn Depot 1203. Lunch 1208 to 1308, Car out 1318, Burnley Park Grove 1321, Hawthorn 1329, Bridge Road & River Street 1336, North Balwyn 1409, Simpson Street 1437 then car in Hawthorn Depot 1458.

After locking up the depot we returned to Camberwell Depot to sign off.
