At the request of Victoria Police, public transport will not run through the CBD between 8am and 2pm. We expect tram frequency will be disrupted from 7am until approximately 3pm while we work to restore the normal timetable.

Route 3a trams run a shortened service between Stop 30 St Kilda Junction and East Malvern, with no trams between St Kilda Junction and Melbourne University.

Route 5

Route 5 trams run a shortened service between Stop 30 St Kilda Junction and Malvern, with no trams between St Kilda Junction and Melbourne University.

Route 6

Route 6 trams run in sections.

Stop 120 Brunswick Road and Moreland Stop 28 Punt Road and Glen Iris.

Route 11

Route 11 trams run a shortened service between Stop 27 Westbourne Grove and West Preston, with no trams between Westbourne Grove and Docklands Precinct.

Route 16 trams run a shortened service between Stop 30 St Kilda Junction and Kew, with no trams between St Kilda Junction and Melbourne University.

Route 19 trams run a shortened service between Stop 20 Melrose Street and North Coburg, with no trams between Stop 20 Melrose Street and Flinders St Station.

No Route 48 trams run between 8am and 2pm.

Due to concurrent tram renewal works in High Street, Kew, buses replace Route 48 trams between Stop 14 Punt Road and North Balwyn.

Route 59 trams run a shortened service between Stop 19 Royal Children's Hospital and Airport West, with no trams between Royal Children's Hospital and Flinders St Station.

Route 64

Route 64 trams run a shortened service between Stop 30 St Kilda Junction and East Brighton, with no trams between St Kilda Junction and Melbourne University.

Route 67

Route 67 trams run a shortened service between Stop 30 St Kilda Junction and Carnegie, with no trams between St Kilda Junction and Melbourne University.

Route 70

Route 70 trams run a shortened service between Stop 29 Riversdale Junction and Wattle Park, with no trams between Riversdale Junction and Docklands Precinct.

Route 72

Route 72 trams run a shortened service between Stop 26 Alfred Hospital and Camberwell, with no trams between Alfred Hospital and Melbourne University.

Route 75

Route 75 trams run a shortened service between Stop 22 Yarra Boulevard and Vermont South, with no trams between Yarra Boulevard and Docklands Precinct.

Route 86

Route 86 trams run a shortened service between Stop 125 Clifton Hill Interchange and Bundoora RMIT, with no trams between Clifton Hill Interchange and Waterfront City Docklands.

Route 96



Route 109

Route 109 trams run a shortened service between Port Melbourne and Stop 125 Clarendon Street Junction.
