SECTION I - DEFINITIONS, SCOPE, INSPECTIONS AND TESTS

1.01 Definitions of Terms

- (f) The term "P.C.C." refers to the Electric Railway Presidents! Conference Committee which developed the general design of the "P.C.C. Car" and various of the improvements incorporated therein, and which has been succeeded by the Transit Research

1.02 Scope
