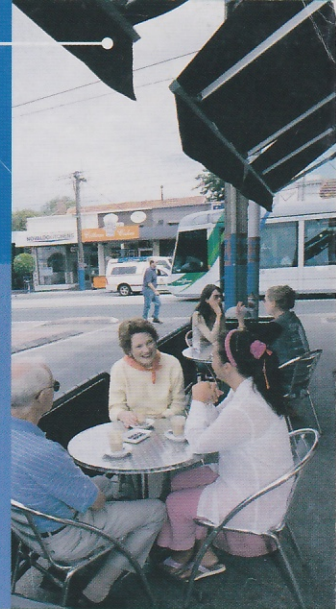

on improving Tram 109

The Boroondara section of tram route 109 is about to undergo significant improvement works to ensure Melbourne's public transport system remains world class.

The project aims to develop solutions to improve tram travel time, reliability, safety and passenger access to the route.

It also presents opportunities to enhance tram stops, local neighbourhood streetscapes and reduce traffic congestion along the route through Kew and Balwyn while retaining residential amenity and access to properties and local businesses.

The Tram 109 project will be an exciting development for Boroondara. The involvement and input of local residents, businesses, community groups or users is vital to achieving the best outcomes for the project and the Boroondara community.

The project forms part of a broader State Government aim to make public transport more attractive, responsive and relevant and to increase its use from the current 9% of all motorised trips to 20% by the year 2020. VicRoads and the City of Boroondara are jointly undertaking community consultation on this State Government initiative.
