

# Notice to Drivers

June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009

---

**Drivers are reminded of your responsibilities in relation to Rule 92:  
Driving on the wrong track or driving from the other end.**

Driving on the wrong track (Bang Road) or from the rear end (Reversing) is not permitted unless authorised and under the controlled supervision of FOC and / or authorised personnel.

Bang Road running is defined as operating in the wrong direction along a double track.

- FOC may only control Bang Road running on reserve tracks or where there is no danger from oncoming traffic. All other Bang Road running is to be supervised by authorised personnel on site.
- If a Driver is required to move a tram back down the track, the Driver must change ends. The Driver is only to proceed if the track is clear and it is safe to do so.

Any driver failing to comply with this rule will face disciplinary action.
