

POST OFFICE EMPLOYEES' TICKETS.

Supplies of a new 5d. P.M.G. prepaid ticket (Specimen below), which are to replace the 4d. P.M.G. tickets have been made available to the Post Master General's Department for the official use of its employees on and after Sunday, 30th October, 1955.

These tickets are to be accepted at face value (5d.) from Post Office Employees in payment or part payment of any fare of 5d. or over on any route.

A Check Ticket to the value of the fare paid will be issued in exchange and, where necessary, cash change will be given.

The number of P.O. tickets received as fares will be entered on Revenue Journals and will be extended at 5d. each before being paid in with other returns for the day.
