



Australian Formula 1 Grand Prix

Thursday 7 to Sunday 10 March, 1996

OVERVIEW

The Australian Grand Prix is expected to attract more than 400,000 people on the four days of the event with 200,000 on Race Day (Sunday 10th March 1996). Public transport, primarily Tram Operations, will be used to provide a safe, effective and reliable service for race goers.

All staff will need to provide our local, interstate and overseas visitors to the Grand Prix with maximum assistance.

This information booklet has been produced to assist staff involved in the first Australian Formula 1 Grand Prix.

Grand Prix Services

LIGHT RAIL SERVICES

No. 96 ROUTE GRAND PRIX GATES 1 & 2

On Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March 1996, the Light Rail will run as normal, supplemented by extras between Latrobe and Spencer streets and Wright Street and Middle Park stations.

On Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March 1996, an express shuttle will operate between Spencer and Collins streets and Wright Street and Middle Park stations.

Passengers will only be picked up and set down at Wright Street Station, Middle Park Station and Spencer Street Station.

B CLASS TRAMS ONLY.

CLARENDON STREET SERVICES

NO. 12 ROUTE GRAND PRIX GATES 3 & 4

Normal services will operate on Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March 1996, supplemented by extensions to Routes 11, 86, and 95 to the South Melbourne Loop.

NOTE: Trams will pick up from all stops on Thursday and Friday.

On SATURDAY 9 and SUNDAY 10 March 1996 normal services will be replaced by a shuttle service, running express from Spencer Street Station to South Melbourne Loop.

NOTE: Loading Point will be Spencer/Collins streets.

Set down point will be South Melbourne Loop (Albert Road).

B CLASS TRAMS ONLY SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.

ST KILDA ROAD SERVICES

GRAND PRIX GATES 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10

On Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March 1996 normal services will run, supplemented by Route No. 22 extending from the Arts Centre to Commercial Road.

On Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March 1996 a Saturday timetable will operate supplemented by a shuttle service (B Class) running from the University to St Kilda Junction.

A shuttle service will also operate between the corner of Dandenong and Glenferrie roads and St Kilda Junction and from Glenhuntly Depot along Brighton Road to St Kilda Junction.

ALTERED SERVICES

Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March 1996

Routes 11, 86 and 95 will be extended from the corner of Bourke and Spencer streets, or Collins Street to the South Melbourne Loop (Albert Road). Route 22 will also be extended to Commercial Road.

Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March 1996

ROUTE 12

Route 12 will be replaced by buses on an alternative route on both days.

ROUTE 96

A bus replacement service will operate on an alternative route from first tram to 20:00 on both days.

CITY CIRCLE

Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March 1996

Normal services to operate.

Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March 1996

This service will be shortened to operate from Flinders/Spencer Street via Flinders, Spring and La Trobe streets to Swanston Street.

TRAIN SERVICES

Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March 1996

Trains will operate on 20 minute frequencies on most lines and 15 minute frequencies on Ringwood, Frankston and Dandenong lines at peak times during the Grand Prix.

BUS SERVICES

Bus services will operate to normal timetables.

General Information

TOILETS

Toilets are located at the following points: South Melbourne Depot, Domain Road Interchange, Franklin Street Signal Box, the Remand Centre, St Kilda Station and Melbourne University Terminus.

MEAL ARRANGEMENTS

All meal breaks will be taken at South Melbourne Depot. A Shuttle Bus will operate to and from the Depot.

COMMAND POSTS

Each major road will have a Command Post.

Command posts will be located at:

CENTRAL COMMAND - ALBERT PARK

LIGHT RAIL - MIDDLE PARK STATION

CLARENDON STREET - SOUTH MELBOURNE LOOP

ST KILDA ROAD - DOMAIN ROAD

Supervision will be provided at each major loading and unloading point.

COMMUNICATIONS/EMERGENCIES

Normal procedures for any communications with F.O.C. apply.

MAJOR LOADING POINTS

SPENCER STREET RAILWAY STATION

Thursday 7 and Friday 8 March 1996

Normal loading will occur at the Bourke Street and Collins Street stops.

Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March 1996

The major loading point will be between Collins and Bourke streets in Spencer Street. All patrons can catch the Grand Prix Express and Clarendon Street Shuttle to gates 1, 2, 3 and 4 from this location.

Spencer Street will be closed for southbound traffic between Lonsdale and Collins streets between 05:00 and 14:00. For the return journey, Spencer Street will be closed to northbound traffic between 16:00 and 20:00.

FLINDERS STREET STATION

On all four days this major loading point will be in Swanston Street between Batman Avenue and Flinders Street. Trams will operate from here as a limited express to gates 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

WRIGHT STREET STATION

For trams from the city (whether an express or service vehicle), unloading will take place in the normal manner.

On Saturday and Sunday loading of passengers for the return will be rostered to have 2 L.R.Vs arrive at the same time. From there trams will run express to Spencer Street Railway Station.

MIDDLE PARK STATION

For trams from the City (whether an express or service vehicle), unloading will take place in the normal manner.

On Saturday and Sunday loading of passengers for the return will be rostered to have 2 L.R.Vs arrive at the same time. From there trams will run express to Spencer Street Railway Station.

ALTERED STOPPING ARRANGEMENTS

On St Kilda Road the following stops will be temporarily bagged, with no collection or dropping off of passengers on Saturday and Sunday.

Stop 14 (City Road), 15 (Arts Centre), 17 (Grant Street), 18 (Coventry Street), 19 (Dorcas Street), 21 (Bowen Crescent), 22 (Toorak Road), 24 (Leopold Street), 28 (Raleigh Street), 29 (Union Road).

Note: Staff will be placed on all express stops. Service cars can be stopped on request by an employee on duty from these stops in special circumstances (ie. disability).

On Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 March route 109 trams will be required to stop as normal at the Exhibition Centre on the "up" and "down".

NEW ROSTERS

For the weeks ending 9 and 16 March 1996, completely new rosters will be in operation at all depots.

STABLING OF TRAMS

Friday and Saturday – Trams may need to be stabled in Kings Way, opposite South Melbourne Tram Depot.

POSTERS / MAPS

An A3 size poster with valuable information for customers will be placed on every tram two weeks prior to the Grand Prix. Notices will also be placed at relevant stops.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

THURSDAY 7 AND FRIDAY 8 MARCH 1996

St Kilda Road – Between Flinders Street and Batman Avenue on the "down" stop, one or both lanes of traffic will be closed depending on the volume of pedestrian traffic.

Safety zones located at Arthur Street, Commercial Road and High Street will be lengthened on the "up" and "down" on a permanent basis before Thursday 7 March.

Barriers – North of the Domain interchange – Barriers will be positioned alongside the tracks on the "up" side along St Kilda Road from Domain Road Interchange to Southbank Boulevard. Access to side streets will be permitted.

Clarendon Street – Police will be controlling intersections along Clarendon Street from City Road to Albert Road to assist in the movement of traffic and trams.

SATURDAY 9 AND SUNDAY 10 MARCH 1996

St Kilda Road – Between Flinders Street and Batman Avenue on the "down" stop, all lanes will be closed to traffic from 06:00 to 14:00.

Closure of St Kilda Road from Southbank Boulevard to Flinders Street will be determined subject to pedestrian traffic.

Barriers – North of the Domain Interchange – Barriers will be positioned alongside the tracks on the "up" side along St Kilda Road from Domain Road Interchange to Southbank Boulevard. Access to side streets will be denied.

Barriers – South of the Domain Interchange –
The centre carriageway of St Kilda Road will be closed
to all traffic except Trams, Taxis and Buses. Road width
alongside the designated safety zones will be narrowed
to only one lane. Right turns at signalised intersections
will be permitted from the service roads with the
assistance of Police.

Clarendon Street - On Saturday and Sunday, Clarendon Street will be closed to traffic from City Road to Albert Road. Barriers will be erected alongside the tram tracks from Coventry Street to Albert Road.

Light Rail - On Saturday and Sunday, all light rail stations except Wright Street and Middle Park will be closed. The Bridport Street crossing will be closed to traffic and pedestrians.

GRAND PRIX GATE LOCATIONS

- Gate 1 Middle Park Station (by light rail from Spencer Street Station)
- Gate 2 Wright Street Station (by light rail from Spencer Street Station)
- Gate 3 & 4 Clarendon Street Services (by trams from Spencer Street. Routes 12, 11, 86 and 95 on Thursday and Friday and the Grand Prix Express service on Saturday and Sunday).
- Gate 5 Domain Road Interchange (by trams along St Kilda Road. Use Routes 3, 5, 6, 8, 16, 64, 67, 72. On Saturday and Sunday Grand Prix extras may also be used).
- Gate 6 & 7 Arthur Street (by trams along St Kilda Road. Use routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67, 72. On Saturday and Sunday Grand Prix extras may also be used).
- Gate 8 Roy Street (by trams along St Kilda Road. Use Routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67, 72. On Saturday and Sunday Grand Prix extras may also be used).
- Gate 9 High Street (by trams along St Kilda Road. Use Routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67. On Saturday and Sunday Grand Prix extras may also be used).

Gate 10 St Kilda Junction is the nearest placed tram stop to this gate (Use trams along St Kilda Road. Use Routes 3, 5, 16, 64 and 67. On Saturday and Sunday Grand Prix extras may also be used).

Gate 11 This entrance is located at Mary Street on Canterbury Road. The closest tram route is No. 16 which can be boarded along St Kilda Road from the University to St Kilda Junction. On Thursday and Friday use Route 96 services (stopping at Fraser Street).
