# NOTICE TO TICKET SELLERS

### **NEW YEARLY TICKETS**

New Zone Yearly tickets available in six different ticket types, will be introduced 1st September, 1989.

Types available will be -:

Zone 1 Zone 2 Zone 3 Zones 1/2 Zones 2/3 Zones 1/2/3

The Yearly tickets will be a smaller, convenient size (same size as Photocard) and will be carried in a new plastic wallet to accommodate both the Yearly ticket and Photocard which will remain separate items.

The Yearly tickets, which will be laminated, will continue to expire the end of the month.

The expiry date will be stamped on the front of the ticket with the large date stamp. The Photocard number will also be endorsed on the front of the Yearly ticket.

#### FAMILY TRAVEL ON WEEKENDS

Existing conditions regarding family travel on weekends will remain i.e. on Saturdays and Sundays any Yearly ticket will permit up to two adults and up to six children under 15 years of age, to unlimited travel on all Met services within all zones, irrespective of the zone(s) shown on the ticket (the holder must be one of the adults travelling).

#### RENEWAL

Yearly tickets may be issued or renewed 3 days prior to the end of the month and may be used immediately. The first day that the new tickets may be issued will be **Tuesday 29 August**, 1989.

## EXISTING NEIGHBOURHOOD YEARLY COMMUTER PASSES

All Yearly Commuter Passes will be honoured until their expiry dates and as mentioned in previous Circular Met 89/6/014 dated 8/6/89, after the new Met Fare Zone System is introduced on 27 August, 1989, Neighbourhood Commuter Passes may be accepted for travel in the new corresponding Zone(s).

## INTERIM CARDS

A new smaller sized Interim Card to be carried in the plastic wallet with the Photocard, will continue to be issued by Railway Stations awaiting supply of Yearly tickets.


Interim Cards will also be stamped on the front of the ticket with the large date stamp to expire 14 days from date of issue. Interim Cards will not be laminated. Interim Cards must be accepted for travel on all Met services within all zones until the expiry date shown.

Interim Cards are also available for Family travel (2 adults and up to 6 children under 15) on Saturdays and Sundays.


