NEW ZONAL MET FARE SYSTEM

PRICE SCHEDULE

EFFECTIVE 27 AUGUST, 1989

MET FARE SYSTEM

The new three zone Met Fare System (replacing the Neighbourhood System) will commence Sunday, 27 August, 1989. New zone tickets will be forwarded to all outlets shortly. A summary of major changes was mentioned in previous Circular Met 89/6/014 dated 8/6/89, pointing out the Fare Zones, Overlaps, Ticket Types and Zone Colours.

Further important information and changes are detailed below.

- 1. Zone 3 comprised of the Ringwood, Dandenong and Frankston Neighbourhoods will NOT be extended to Warburton and Portsea as previously advised. (The \$1.00 60 Plus ticket, however, may continue to be available for travel to Warburton and Portsea.)
- 2. The term "Travelcard" will no longer be used, although tickets remain available for multi-modal travel. The new zone tickets will simply be called 3 Hour, Daily, Weekly, Monthly, Yearly.
- 3. The Off Peak Ticket (\$1.20) will be abolished with the last issue date, Saturday, 26 August, 1989. It has been decided to retain Sixty Saver Concession Cards and School Excursion Metro politan Yearly tickets. As mentioned recently, new Yearly tickets will be introduced. All the new fares are shown in this schedule.
- 4. As previously advised daily Bulk Issue Travelcards have been abolished and ordinary Daily, Weekly and Monthly tickets will be issued instead. These tickets are currently being used by Government Departments including Department of Health, Community Services Victoria, various City Councils, etc.
 - NOTE: (i) In order for these Departments to deplete existing Neighbourhood ticket stock of Bulk Issue Travelcards, Weekly Travelcards and Monthly tickets, these tickets may continue to be accepted for travel in their corresponding zone(s) until 30 September, 1989.
 - (ii) There may be some instances when the new zone Daily tickets are presented for travel which have not been validated. Should a Daily ticket not previously validated be presented for travel, punch appropriate month and day.
- 5. Reminder regarding new 3 Hour and Daily Tickets -
 - (i) As the time limit for all part day tickets will become 3 Hours, these tickets will all be punched at the next full hour and no advance punching is necessary. 3 Hour tickets will remain 28 day stock.
 - (ii) All Daily tickets will become continuous stock and will be validated by punching the appropriate month and day.
- 6. There will be no changes to fares, ticket types or transfer charges for Student Passes and Tertiary Student Concession Cards until the next school year (1990).

Further advice will be forwarded by Circular towards the end of this year.

From 27 August, 1989 Student Passes may be used for travel in the corresponding zone(s).

7. Ticket Sellers are reminded that 2 Section Short Distance tickets are only valid for use for up to two sections on one vehicle. Persons wishing to travel two sections necessitating a vehicle change must purchase a 3 Hour or Daily ticket.
