Attention all Slide Workers - competition closing date 24 September 2009

The Melbourne Camera Club will again present an "**open slide**" competition for current slide workers. The competition is open to any members from a VAPS affiliated club and the aim of this competition is to offer VAPS members the opportunity to develop their slide-photography skills, be compared with other current slide workers and critiqued by competition judges. The intention is to encourage slide workers to compete in National and International slide competitions and ensure a future for slide photography.

Rules:

- There are no grades and just one section, "open slide"
- Individual slide workers can enter up to 4 slides
- Entrants must make the original exposure, but processing by other persons or commercially is acceptable
- Slides must have standard 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") plastic mounts
- Each entry must include the title, entrant's initials and a black dot in the lower left hand corner (as viewed right side up when held in hand)
- Slide entries are to be submitted to the MCC Slide Steward by COB (on the dates listed below) at the postal address listed below; or hand delivered to the MCC rooms by 9.00pm that evening
- As was the case last time, the first, second and third place getters will receive a trophy, and other slides may be offered Highly Commended or Commended awards (at the judge's discretion)
- The slides will be shown at 12.30pm i.e. just prior to the VAPS AGM meeting on Sunday 18 October. Slides will be available to be picked up that day, or returned to entrants by post thereafter (workers requiring entries to be returned by post to include a stamped, self-addressed envelope)
