LAST MEETING COMPETITION RESULTS:

Guest Judge was David Torrington who is a well-known Ballarat Wedding Portrait Photographer. His comments on the small prints were very constructive and came from the experience of photographing over 750 weddings. He also gave very detailed comments on the slides and large prints sections which emphasised the importance of lighting, exposure, sharpness and trying to make the shot different in some way. The results are as follows:

Following the judging, David presented some examples of his own personal photography which favoured abstract shots of buildings, use of black and white for effect and beautiful night shots. He also spoke of his love of the technical aspect of photography and gave some handy hints to produce that special lighting effect.

DIGITAL GROUP

We will also look at experiences with photos printed externally that do not come out as expected.

Inkjet printing problems of fading and off colour will also be discussed.
