Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.

Prints up to 7in \times 5in, or 35sq in (panorama) mounted on a board up to 10in \times 8in.

2 Large prints (Open), Prints up to $20in \times 16in$ mounted on a board up to $20in \times 16in$.

2 Projected images (Circles);

An object or objects which as seen by the camera are circular or contain circles.

Images must not exceed 1400 pixels wide x 1050 pixels high.

File size for each image must not exceed 1000 mb.
