





2 Small prints (Open),

Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition. Prints up to 7in x 5in, or 35sq in (panorama) mounted on a board up to 10in x 8in.

2 Large prints (Open), Prints up to 20in x 16in mounted on a board up to 20in x 16in.

2 Projected images (Shadows);

A picture in which the shadow is featured. The cause of the shadow may be included but must not be dominant.

Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high. File size for each image must not exceed 5 mb. Save in JPG format.

Syllabus Change, June: EDIs subject is Mirrors & Small Print is Open.
