Bring to September Meeting:

2 Small prints (Set Subject - Drips and Drops)

- A picture of a fluid dripping or in drops on an interesting surface
- ** Prints must not exceed $180 \text{mm} \times 125 \text{mm}$ (7in $\times 5 \text{in}$), mounted on a board which must not exceed $250 \text{mm} \times 200 \text{mm}$ ($10 \text{in} \times 8 \text{in}$). Mounting thickness must not exceed 5 mm.

2 Projected images (Open)

- Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition
- ** Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high.
- ** File size for each image must not exceed 5mb. Save in JPG format.
- ** Image file names must begin with the member's code number, linked by an underscore, with the title of the image eg. 025_A Day at the Beach.jpg
