## Events pencil into your diary

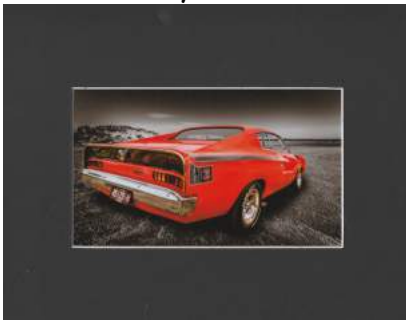


- Time to round up images taken by family members for Small images for competition entry at the December meeting.

- **\*\* Prints must not exceed 180mm x 125mm (7in x 5in), mounted on a board which must not exceed 250mm x 200mm (10in x 8in). Mounting thickness must not exceed 5mm.**
