

A word from the Print Stewart

Over recent months there has been an increasing number of small prints being submitted for monthly competition where the mounting boards are too large. Members are reminded that prints must not exceed 180mm \times 125mm (7in \times 5in), mounted on a board which must not exceed 250mm \times 200mm (10in \times 8in). Failure to adhere to these requirements may render your small print ineligible for inclusion in monthly competition.

OUT OF THE HAT:

Don't forget to keep working on your "Out of the Hat" set subjects.

Bring to June 2019 Meeting:

x2 Small prints (Open)

- Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.
- ** Prints must not exceed 180mm \times 125mm (7in \times 5in), mounted on a board which must not exceed 250mm \times 200mm (10in \times 8in). Mounting thickness must not exceed 3mm.

x2 Projected images (Set Subject - "Architecture")

- A picture of buildings or structures, (ancient of modern, interior or exterior), monuments, columns, bridges, or parts thereof.
- ** Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high.
- ** File size for each image must not exceed 5mb. Save in JPG format.
- ** Image file names must begin with the member's code number, linked by an underscore, with the title of the image eg. 025_A Day at the Beach.jpg

x2 Large Prints (Open)

- Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.
- ** Prints must not exceed 500mm x 400mm (20in x 16in) mounted on a board which must not exceed 500mm x 400mm (20in x 16in). Mounting thickness must not exceed 3mm.

(Remember to keep image titles for all images to no more than 3 or 4 words)
