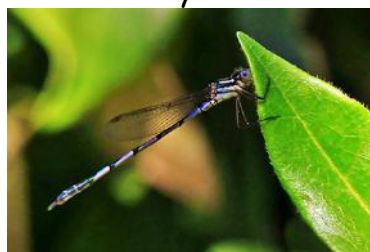

Bring to July 2019 Meeting:

x2 Small prints (Set subject - "Critters")

- *A photograph of any animal, reptile, bird, fish, insect, spider or crustacean.*
- *** Prints must not exceed 180mm x 125mm (7in x 5in), mounted on a board which must not exceed 250mm x 200mm (10in x 8in). Mounting thickness must not exceed 3mm.*

x2 Projected images (Open)

- *Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.*
- *** Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high.*
- *** File size for each image must not exceed 5mb. Save in JPG format.*
- *** **Image file names** must begin with the member's code number, linked by an underscore, with the title of the image eg. 025_A Day at the Beach.jpg*

x2 Large Prints (Open)

- *Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.*
- *** Prints must not exceed 500mm x 400mm (20in x 16in) mounted on a board which must not exceed 500mm x 400mm (20in x 16in). Mounting thickness must not exceed 3mm.*

(Remember to keep image titles for all images to no more than 3 or 4 words)
