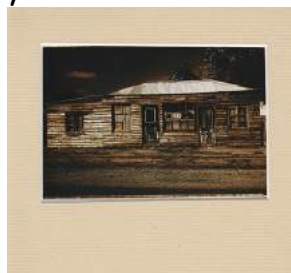

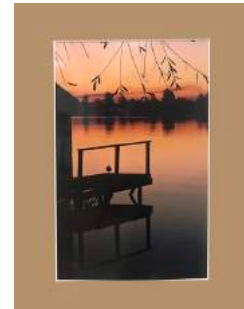

- **** Prints must not exceed 180mm x 125mm (7in x 5in), mounted on a board which must not exceed 250mm x 200mm (10in x 8in). Mounting thickness must not exceed 3mm.**

(Remember to keep image titles for all images to no more than 3 or 4 words)
