RESIZING EDI IMAGES

At the end of the next club meeting Lois & Gavin Dent and Trevor Parry will be available for a one on one hands on talk for resizing your EDI photo to competition standard. For those interested please bring along some photos on a clean USB stick then the above will show you how to resize.

x2 Small prints (Open)

** Prints must not exceed 7in x 5in (approx 180mm x 125mm), mounted on a board which must be 10in x 8in (approx 250mm x 200mm). Thickness including mounting must not exceed 5mm.

x2 Projected images (Symmetry)

- A balance of objects, shapes, reflections, or colours. Man made or occurring naturally.
- *Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.*
- ** *Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high.*
- ** *File size for each image must not exceed 5mb. Save in JPG format.*
- ** **Image file names** must begin with the member's code number, linked by an underscore, with the title of the image eg. 025_A Day at the Beach.jpg

x2 Large Prints (Ballarat Heritage)

- A picture representing an iconic Ballarat landmark or feature.
- *Any subject treated pictorially, ie. zGood design, arrangement and composition.*
- ** *Prints must not exceed 20in x 16in (approx 500mm x 400mm) mounted on a board which must be 20in x 16in (approx 500mm x 400mm). Thickness including mounting must not exceed 5mm.*
