

x2 Small prints (Horses)

Photo must include part or whole aspect of at least one horse.

** Prints must not exceed 7in x 5in (approx 180mm x 125mm), mounted on a board which must be 10in x 8in (approx 250mm x 200mm). Thickness including mounting must not exceed 5mm.

x2 Projected images (Open)

- Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.
- ** Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high.
- ** File size for each image must not exceed 5mb. Save in JPG format.
- ** Image file names must begin with the member's code number, linked by an underscore, with the title of the image eg. 025 A Day at the Beach.jpg

x2 Large Prints (Open)

- Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.
- ** Prints must not exceed 20in x 16in (approx 500mm x 400mm) mounted on a board which must be 20in x 16in (approx 500mm x 400mm). Thickness including mounting must not exceed 5mm.

In Memory of Judy Johnson



Judy joined the club in 1969 and quickly became a valued club member contributing to the overall success of the club with both her willingness to give up her time to serve on various club committees as well as with her exceptional skill with a camera. Judy's efforts were rewarded in 1994 when she was recognised by receiving the VAPS Service Award, which is given for exceptional services within a camera club and in the advancement of the camera club movement in Victoria. In 1996 Judy was awarded life membership with the club. During her membership Judy has served on the executive committee a total of 13 years, 4 of which as president. Judy also spent 9 years as editor of the newsletter. As busy as she was with club activities Judy's success with a camera was even greater making Judy arguably the most successful and influential photographer in the history of the club. Her ability to compose an image no matter the subject material was second to none. A list of her award achievements is long indeed and includes the following:
