## Bring to the June 2022 Meeting

**PLEASE NOTE THAT EDI, SMALL AND LARGE PRINTS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE NIGHT.**

x2 Small prints (Open)

- Any subject treated pictorially, ie. Good design, arrangement and composition.
- \*\* Prints must not exceed 7in x 5in (approx 180mm x 125mm), mounted on a board which must be 10in x 8in (approx 250mm x 200mm). Thickness including mounting must not exceed 5mm.

x2 Large Prints (Triptych)

- A set of three pictures on a related subject on a mounting board of large print size in a format of the makers choice.
- \*\* Prints must not exceed 20in x 16in (approx 500mm x 400mm) mounted on a board which must be 20in x 16in (approx 500mm x 400mm). Thickness including mounting must not exceed 5mm.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO AN ALTERATION IN JUDGING ARRANGEMENTS, EDI ENTRIES WILL NEED TO BE UPLOADED TO THE CLUBS WEBSITE NO LATER THAN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE MEETING. THIS MEANS THAT EDI ENTRIES WILL BE REQUIRED TO BY UPLOADED NO LATER THAN MIDNIGHT TUESDAY 7th Jun 2022**

x2 Projected images (Mans Best Friend)

- An image featuring a dog as the main subject in any environment or situation.
- \*\* Images must not exceed 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high.
- \*\* File size for each image must not exceed 5mb. Save in JPG format.
- \*\* Image file names must begin with the member's code number, linked by an underscore, with the title of the image eg. 025\_A Day at the Beach.jpg
