Update from the Committee

A special meeting for all members was held on Tuesday 21st 2023 at the club rooms. The topic of discussion was the future of Ballarat Photography Group as a viable club. Given our diminishing numbers we have come to a crossroad with regards our ability to function as a club and meet the statutory requirements under the Associations Incorporations Reform Act 2012. There were 3 options for consideration, 1 Continue as is; 2 Amalgamate with another club or 3 wind up and cancel the club. After much discussion and input by those present it was unanimously voted that option 3 was the recommended choice. This recommendation will be presented at the meeting on March 14th. Members are urged to attend the meeting or complete a proxy form as we need 75% of members to vote in order to achieve an outcome under the Act. Proxy votes can only be accepted if completed on the required form. Proxy forms were emailed out to members earlier this week. Contact Dianne Fletcher if you require a proxy form.
